<p><b>Whitaker International Program</b>  The Whitaker International Program sends emerging leaders in U.S. biomedical engineering (or bioengineering) overseas to undertake a self-designed project that will enhance their careers within the field (graduating seniors to post-doctoral degrees). <b>Will take chemical, electrical or mechanical with background or interest in biomedicine.</b> The goal of the program is to assist the development of professional leaders who are not only superb scientists, but who also will advance the profession through an international outlook.
