

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS HOUSING OFFICE

Q: Who is required to reside on campus?

A: Freshmen, sophomore and first year transfer students (students having less than 60 hours cumulative) are required to live on campus and to participate in the central dining hall meal plan.

Q: What are the Freshman Halls?

A: Female Freshman Halls are: Adams Hall, Sage Hall, and Douglas Hall.  
Male Freshman Halls are: Banneker Hall and Bethune Hall.

Q: What other housing is available for Upper-class Students?

A: Female Upper-class Halls are: Russell Hall, Harvey Hall, White Hall and Younge Hall.  
Male Upper-class Halls are: Banneker Hall, Rockefeller Hall and Tantum Hall.  
Co-ed Hall: James Hall is a special Bioethics co-ed Hall.

Q: What Apartments are available at Tuskegee University?

A:

- The Commons Apartments have 2 and 4 bedroom apartments designed for Tuskegee University students who have completed four (4) semesters of studies and have a minimum of 55 credit hours and a GPA of 2.3 or higher.
- The Marable Apartments have 2 bedroom apartments designed for Tuskegee University students who have completed four (4) semesters of studies and have a minimum of 55 credit hours and a CGPA of 2.3 or higher.

Q: When do I apply for housing?

A: Application Deadlines for housing are as follows:

- Fall – March 30
- Spring – October 30
- Summer – March 31

Q: When will I receive my housing assignment?

A: Mail-Out Dates for housing assignments are as follows:

- Fall – on or before July 13
- Spring – on or before November 30
- Summer – on or before May 10
  
- Freshman students will receive all of their information—including housing application—from the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Management, after they have been accepted and have paid the required pre-enrollment fee.
  
- How do I get my housing deposit refund?
  - Come into the Housing Office and fill out a Housing Separate Form. The Housing Office will submit the form to the Office of the Bursar to check for a balance on your student account. Any remaining amount will be refunded to you.
