At their July 2020 meeting, the directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) streamlined the interim reporting process.

Effective January 1, 2021, the Five-Year IPR submissions will now only be required for programs whose Two-Year or Three-Year IPR did not satisfy deficiencies stated in the previous VTR.

Your program's Two-Year IPR demonstrated it had satisfied all deficiencies in the previous VTR; therefore, your program is not required to submit a Five-Year IPR in 2022.
