A Minimum of three (3) Evaluations required by VMCAS and submitted through VMCAS electronically. This is separate from the supplemental vet evaluation required.		
Supplemental Application and Supplemental Application Fee (\$100 Money order or Cashier's Check) Made out to TUCVM and mailed to the address below.		
Supplemental Veterinarian Evaluation (1 required but you can submit more if you like) Mailed or emailed to vetadmissions@tuskegee.edu or jstoneback@tuskegee.edu		
Transcripts (Sent to VMCAS 2 weeks prior to deadline) Make sure that you send all your transcripts to VMCAS **If you have a StraighterLine transcript Send it directly to TUCVM. **		
Standardized Test Scores (GRE: University Code 1813) Then choose Veterinary Science. TUCVM requires the GRE for all applicants
