APPLICATION FOR HOUSING IN RESIDENCE HALLS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING APPLICATION

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT IN INK AND COMPLETE IN FULL

1. Securing a room requires the student to complete an application and pay the required \$500.00 pre-enrollment fee before June 15 for Fall semester and October 15 for Spring Semester.
2. All room assignments for the Fall semester will be mailed no later than June 30th.
3. **Freshmen, sophomores and first year transfer students, (students having less than 60 hours cumulative) are required to live on campus and to participate in the central dining hall meal program.**
4. Exempt from resident hall: Veterans, Married Students, Two or more family members attending school from the same household with one person enrolled with 60 credit hours or more at the start of Fall semester, Independent students at least 24 years of age, Macon County residents established prior to enrollment at Tuskegee University. If a student is not independent using Federal Title IV financial aid regulations, residency can be established at the Fall semester, only upon receipt of proof of parents residence in Macon County.
5. If a transfer student has 60 credit hours, cumulative from another school or college, they may live in a Residence Hall or Apartment. If student selects a Residence Hall, the meal plan is required. The meal plan is not required in the apartments.
6. Two or more members of the same family living in the residence hall, are eligible for \$500.00 per year credit per person. This discount will be applied toward their room and board rate. This plan does not apply if the Alabama incentive plan or another University room plan is being used.
