No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 60 days. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities and technical errors if, in the Owner's judgment, the best interest of the Owner will thereby be promoted. All bidders shall meet licensing requirements of Title 34, Chapter 8, Code of Alabama and must show evidence of license before bidding or bid will not be received or considered. Bidder shall show such evidence by clearly displaying its current license number on the outside of the sealed envelope in which the proposal is delivered.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS:
