# **Key Terms**

## Respondent

Any student charged with a violation of the Student Codes of Conduct

### Preponderance


Preponderance of evidence is when it is more likely than not that the alleged incident occurred

#### Sanctions

Includes response or requirements given by the University to a student during an administrative conference in response to a violation of the Codes of Conduct

### Chairperson

Refers to the Conduct Administrator who is authorized by the Vice President of Student Affairs and Enrollment Management or his/her designee to take the lead role in conducting conferences when there's more than one Student Conduct Administrator present



Case is closed and record is retained in the Office of the Dean of Students and Judicial Affairs
