TVSP Program Description

- Runs for 10-12 weeks from May 20, 2024
- Purpose is to expose veterinary students to research and introduce them to research-oriented career options through various activities
- Each student will work on a project with a Faculty Mentor
- Students present their work at a symposium
- Social activities and day trip/s

Application: now through March 1, 2024

Award Notification by Friday, March 22, 2024

Start research on Monday, May 20, 2024

Only accepted will be notified

Options

- **HHS-COE option**
 - 10 weeks research in TUCVM
 - Symposium presentation at TU One Health Symposium (September) or elsewhere
- **T35 collaboration with Mississippi option**
 - 12 weeks at TU or MSU
 - Symposium presentation in Minnesota and at TU One Health Symposium
- **Boehringer Ingelheim Scholar option**
 - 10 weeks at TU
 - Symposium presentation at Tufts and at TU one health symposium
- **Stipends are about \$520/week rates for 2024 (may be higher, TBD)**
- **2nd year veterinary students have the option of doing clinics-based research if they find a mentor; 1st year veterinary students work mainly with basic science faculty or projects.**
- **AND Lots of Educational and Professional Development activities besides research**
