TVSP Program Description

- Runs for 12 weeks from May 19, 2025
- Purpose is to expose veterinary students to research and introduce them to research-oriented career options thru various activities
- Each student will work on a project with a Faculty Mentor
- Students present their work at a symposium
- Social activities and potential day trip/s to Medical Center for Comparative Medicine, Jackson, MS; Emory University Primate Lab, Atlanta, GA; or Auburn State Diagnostic Lab, Auburn, AL

HHS-COE option

T35 collaboration with Mississippi option

- •12 weeks at TU or MSU
- Symposium presentation in Spokane, WA and at TU One Health Symposium

Boehringer Ingelheim Scholar option

- •12 weeks at TU
- •Symposium presentation at Spokane, WA and TU One Health Symposium

Stipends are about \$600/week rates for 2025 (may be higher, TBD)

2nd year veterinary students have the option of doing clinics-based research if they find a mentor; 1st year veterinary students work mainly with basic science faculty or projects.

During the program, an option to work two weeks with a clinical faculty for a clinical experience.
