

## HEERF I, II and III | Emergency Student Aid Quarter Ended March 31, 2022

Tuskegee University (TU) provides Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Aid to students.

TU signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Department of Education. The University pledged to award applicable amount of the CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP Funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

As of May 14, 2021, TU received a total of \$9,113,362 in COVID – 19 funds designated for distribution to students in the form of Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a) (1) of the CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP.

A total distribution of \$1,500 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants were paid to students in the first quarter ended March 31, 2022. TU intends to disburse the remaining balance of \$1,678,828 to students for the Spring 2022 Semester, not later than April 30, 2022.
