**Steps for Applying to the Graduate Programs  
(Master in Veterinary Science and Interdisciplinary Pathobiology PhD)**

1. Decide what degree you want
2. Decide your field of interest
3. Visit our website at: <http://www.onemedicine.tuskegee.edu/ADRAS/home.htm>
  - a) Choose **Overview** (tab on the top of the page to have an idea of what degrees we offer and the areas of interests of our faculty
  - b) Go back and choose **Requirements** (write down the requirements for the degree that you seek admissions. Make sure that you have all the requirements for admission)
  - c) Go back and choose **Faculty and Staff Profiles** (write down the names and the contact information for the faculty that you think match your interest)
  - d) Contact those faculties to see if they have an opening for you as a graduate student in their laboratories (if they have a research project going on, financial support for you, etc.)
  - e) If you find a faculty member who is willing to accept as your major advisor then go back to the website, using the same steps above, and choose **Requirements** then from the same tab choose **Application Process** then apply online
