Goal \$5.5 million*

Tuskegee University was founded as a teachers school in 1881 by the Alabama Legislature, and the School of Education continues that proud tradition today. Their training is foundational to their careers, from the classroom to the boardroom, and requires investment to keep pace with a rapidly changing world. - A **Center for Excellence in Teaching** to focus on improving student excellence and outcomes
- Enhance the **Students First Road from Early Achievement to a Career High (REACH) academic coaching and peer tutoring service** with new tools including an **advanced artificial intelligence-enabled student assistant to deliver personalized math tutoring 24/7**
- A **National Education Policy Think Tank** to attract research faculty who focus on influencing K-12 education reform and leadership development

- A **new Ph.D. program** to address the crisis in literacy, declines in math competency, and other challenges
