

Research Experience for Undergraduates (REU) in NanoBio Materials Science and Engineering

Program Dates: May 26, 2026- July 24,2026

This National Science Foundation (NSF)-funded, ten-week summer program is designed for undergraduate students from four-year institutions and community colleges, particularly those with limited access to research facilities at their home institutions. The program aims to inspire and prepare participants to pursue graduate studies at Tuskegee University and other leading institutions.

Participants will engage in advanced research projects under the mentorship of faculty members and graduate students. In addition to hands-on research experience, students will take part in professional development activities and visit nearby industries to gain exposure to real-world applications.

Each participant will receive a stipend of \$6,000, along with up to \$500 for travel expenses. Students will be housed in Tuskegee University dormitories and provided meals through campus dining facilities.
