The students in the senior capstone course are developing a new product and you are assigned to work with them on the sensory evaluation aspect. You are asked to coordinate, plan and execute the appropriate test and provide conclusions for the consumer acceptance of the product. You are also asked to provide a concise (3-4 pages) report to be incorporated into the document for the Southeast IFT (SEIFT) Product Development Competition.
