



FALL '26 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATION WINDOW

- Students must apply to the Aviation Science Program August 1, 2025 - December 1, 2025
- Students who are admitted to Tuskegee University must be interviewed by the Aviation Science Director before being accepted into the Tuskegee University Aviation Science Program.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Students must submit SAT/ACT Test Scores - 1080 SAT / 21 ACT

PROOF OF US CITIZENSHIP OR PERMANENT RESIDENT

- Valid, unexpired U.S. passport and copy of birth certificate
- Original birth certificate with raised seal, documenting birth in the United States or one of its territories

HOLD A VALID US DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PERMIT

Students are prohibited from flight training at Tuskegee University without a U.S. Driver's license or learners permit.

MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE

Students are prohibited from beginning training at Tuskegee University before the age of 18.

OBTAIN FAA FIRST CLASS MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

To be a Commercial Airline Pilot, the FAA requires that you have a FAA 1st Class Medical Certificate. We want to ensure that you meet the requirements to be a commercial pilot before you begin any of your flight training.

PASS TSA BACKGROUND CHECK AND DRUG SCREENING

Upon Acceptance into the TU Aviation Science Program, students will be required to complete a separate LIFT Academy application and pass TSA Background Check and Drug Screening, which can be found at www.flywithlift.com.
