DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

All accepted Tuskegee University Aviation Science students are required to complete a separate application to the LIFT Academy at flywithlift.com

The must be able to provide the following:

- Must be 18+ years of age
- Proof of U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Hold a valid U.S. driver's license
- Proof of high school completion or equivalent
- Obtain a valid FAA First Class Medical
- Pass TSA Background Check
- Pass Drug Screening

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DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OF U.S. CITIZENS

All new students must bring one of the following when attending New Student Orientation:

- Valid, unexpired U.S. passport and copy of birth certificate
- Original birth certificate with raised seal, documenting birth in the United States or one of its territories
- Original U.S. naturalization certificate with raised seal (Form N-550 or Form N-570)
- Original certification of birth abroad (Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350)
- Original certificate of U.S. citizenship (Form N-560 or Form N-561)



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FAA MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

All new students must bring one of the following when attending New Student Orientation:

- Current First-Class medical certificate
 - Students participating in the Tuskegee Aviation Science Program will be required to obtain a FAA 1st Class Medical Certificate before applying to the program.
- All medical certificates must show your full legal name (U.S. citizens must match birth certificate / International students must match Passport)

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
