- **VMCAS (Veterinary Medical College Application Service) Application**
 - A complete VMCAS application includes:
 - Completed application
 - Application fee paid (VMCAS Fee)
 - A minimum of three (3) eLORs (electronic letters of recommendation)
 - All transcripts for institutions listed in “Institutions Attended.”

 - \$100.00 Supplemental Application Fee – money order, cashier’s check or certified check made payable to TUCVM.

 - There is no way to pay the fee online.

- **Standardized Test Scores (GRE)**
 - Scores of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) must be received by the Office of Veterinary Admissions by October 1st. University Code: 1813
 - GRE must be taken within the last three years.
- **Transcripts**
 - Official transcripts are required to be submitted to AAVMC before the September deadline date. Visit AAVMC’s website for more information on transcript verification.
 - Be sure to send them two weeks or more prior to the deadline to VMCAS.
 - Do not send StraighterLine Transcripts to VMCAS (they do not accept them), send them directly to TUCVM at jstoneback@tuskegee.edu or vetadmissions@tuskegee.edu
