- **VMCAS (Veterinary Medical College Application Service) Application**
 - A complete VMCAS application includes:
 - Completed application
 - Application fee paid (VMCAS Fee)
 - A minimum of three (3) eLORs (electronic letters of recommendation)
 - All transcripts for institutions listed in “Institutions Attended.”

- **Tuskegee University CVM Supplemental Application**
 - Upload this form to the additional documents portion in VMCAS.
 - \$100.00 Supplemental Application Fee – money order, cashier’s check or certified check made payable to TUCVM.
 - Fee can be dropped by the office at Patterson Hall office A109 or mailed.
 - There is no way to pay the fee online at this moment.
- **Veterinarian Evaluation Form**This is different than the ones sent to VMCAS.**
 - Can be uploaded to VMCAS by student, mailed to TUCVM office or emailed.

- **Transcripts**
 - Official transcripts are required to be submitted to AAVMC before the September deadline date. Visit AAVMC’s website for more information on transcript verification.
 - Be sure to send them two weeks or more prior to the deadline to VMCAS.
 - Do not send StraighterLine Transcripts to VMCAS (they do not accept them), send them directly to TUCVM at vetadmissions@tuskegee.edu
