Avia Sutton, MPH, MS, GC, is a neurology genetic counselor in the [UT Health Austin Pediatric Neurosciences at Dell Children's](#), a clinical partnership between Dell Children's Medical Center and UT Health Austin. Working with children with epilepsy, autism, and other neurodevelopmental conditions to find an underlying genetic cause for their diagnosis.

Avia earned her bachelor's degree in behavioral neuroscience from Nova Southeastern University in Florida, her master's degree in public health from Tuskegee University, and her master's degree in genetic counseling from the University of North Carolina, Greensboro. She completed an internship at the Research Triangle Institute (RTI), the North Carolina Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Related Disabilities (LEND) fellowship at the Carolina Institute for Developmental Disabilities, a multispecialty rotation at Cone Health, and additional training in adult and pediatric neurology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Her clinical interests focus on pediatric neurology and prenatal counseling, and her research interests include neurodevelopmental disabilities, public health genetics and education, and patient advocacy.
