TVSP Program Description

- Runs for 12 weeks from May 19, 2025 (includes laboratory research and clinical experience at the VTH)
- Purpose is to expose veterinary students to research and introduce them to research-oriented career options thru various activities
- Each student will work on a project with a Faculty Mentor
- Clinical Experience in the VTH with clinical faculty
- Students present their work at symposia
- Social activities and day trip/s to one or more of: Medical Center for Comparative Medicine, Jackson, MS; Emory University Primate Lab, Atlanta, GA; or Auburn State Diagnostic Lab, Auburn, AL

Award Notification by Friday, March 14, 2025



Start research on Monday, May 19, 2025

- 12 weeks total at TU
- Symposium presentation in Spokane, WA and TU One Health Symposium

Stipends are about \$650/week
(rates for 2025 may be higher,
TBD)

2nd year veterinary students have the option of doing clinics-based research if they find a mentor;
1st year veterinary students work mainly with basic science faculty or projects.

NEW: During the program, an option of two weeks with a clinical faculty for a clinical experience at TUCVM VTH.
