Important Information for Parents and Students

Dear Parents and Students,

Starting March 16th, you will receive your awards letter along with helpful information to guide you through the financial aid process. Our goal is to support you in understanding your funding options and ensuring your student's successful enrollment for Fall 2026.

Additional Funding

Limited additional funding will be available for qualifying students. Details will follow in the coming weeks after awards are issued.

Outside Scholarships

Please email outside scholarships to finaid@tuskegee.edu with your student's name and ID. We will record these until the funds are received.

Note: If your student has full scholarships from Tuskegee and outside scholarships, the university's scholarship will be adjusted accordingly to prevent overages. This is outlined in your acceptance letter.

Who We Are

The Financial Aid Office helps students and parents understand scholarship opportunities (e.g., UNCF, Thurgood Marshall) and federal aid (loans, grants). While we provide guidance, students should contact their departments directly for scholarship offerings.

Cost of Attendance (COA)

The current COA is **\$46,364** annually. This is not the billed amount but the maximum funding available per year. If costs increase, the COA will be adjusted, and you will be notified in advance.

Estimated Annual Costs:

- Tuition: \$21,802
- Room: \$4,793
- Meal Plan: \$5,490
- Fees: \$4,524

The Bursar bills per semester, but financial aid awards cover the full year (split between fall and spring).

Work-Study

If interested, students will be notified if work-study funds are available after classes start. Earnings are paid directly to students and are not credited toward tuition.

Our Commitment

We wish we could fund every student fully. We will assist as much as possible, but the university must remain financially sustainable. It's essential for students and parents to stay engaged, communicate with departments, and ensure all funding is in place for Fall 2026.
